A huge art installation has been revealed in Liverpool Cathedral. This piece has been created by artist and sculpture Peter Walker. It is illuminated by a light show and accompanied by a soundtrack, "Ruah Quaeska" composed by David Harper.

There are around 18.000 paper doves suspended on 15.5 miles of ribbon that include prayers and messages of peace written by thousands of school children and others. This is an interactive art installation where visitors can place a button inside the shape of a giant dove and look back at the past year to remember those who have lost their lives.

The installation opened Friday 20th May and runs until August 31st.
