

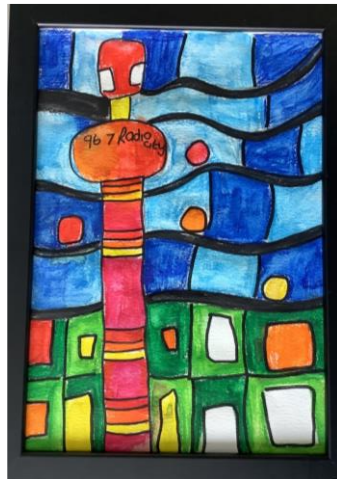
ALT BRIDGE CULTURAL NEWS
